The Temperature Log

This document is intended to be read after the 'New User' information packet. For information regarding personal account information and setup, please refer to that guide. It is available at the BFHD VacTrack site at www.bfhd.wa.gov/vactrack

The Temperature Log tracking page is a simple one part form that tracks the date you send your Temperature Logs to BFHD. If there were no temperature variations outside the prescribed parameters, please be sure to check the 'Logs Clean' check box. When you click 'Send' on the form row corresponding to the Temp Log due date, a comment is required. Please state how the logs were sent, and perhaps who you sent them to. This will help the BFHD staff locate them and then allow us to confirm receipt on our version of this form. When BFHD confirms the receipt, the date will appear in the 'Received' column. The Temp Log form currently shows the last four months of temperature logs if available. At the beginning of every month, a new row will appear with a due date for the previous month's temperature logs.

This sample log shows that BFHD has submitted Temperature Logs for November, December and January on February 25th. All those logs were clean, but the notes were not clear and descriptive. The logs for November (due 12/1/2009) and December (due 1/1/2010) were received on 2/25/2010, but the logs for January (due 2/1/2010) have not been received. Because the Notes are not descriptive, BFHD will need to be contacted directly and the confusion managed outside the BFHD VacTrack system. The Logs for February (due 3/1/2010) have not yet been sent, and offer us the opportunity to submit them with appropriately descriptive Notes, and since the logs were clean, I'll be sure to check the 'Logs Clean' checkbox.
